

Advanced Nurse Practitioner

Advanced Nurse Practitioners are all trained specialist nurses who have undertaken additional education to provide advanced nursing care and prescribe. They can assess and examine, make a diagnosis and provide advice and treatment including a prescription if required. They can request blood tests, investigations and refer patients with an urgent clinical need to hospital.

Same day appointments are available every weekday.
