## **CLINICAL PHARMACIST TEAM**

The Clinical Pharmacy team consists of highly experienced registered **GPhC** clinical pharmacists and pharmacy technicians who have worked in both hospital and community settings. They work as part of the healthcare team at Westgate with the main role being to improve patient care around medication use.

A few examples of what they do include:

Being experts in medicines use, they are available on the day to answer any medication related queries from both clinicians and patients.

They conduct annual medication reviews ensuring medicines are effective, safe and still needed. These medication reviews are structured which provides patients an opportunity to ask questions about their medicines and address any concerns they may have.

As part of the review, they look for any potential drug interactions or effects: side our Clinical Pharmacists are all independent prescribers so are qualified to safely adjust dosages, optimise treatment, or initiate medicines where appropriate.

Park runs are free nationwide events that take place every Saturday morning at 9am. You get to complete a 5km route with others in a friendly environment, whether that be by running, walking, alone or with friends, a push buggy or with a dog. They action clinic letters and discharge letters from hospital, ensuring that any new proposed medication changes from the hospital are safe and appropriate with the patient's existing regime.

The clinical pharmacist team also lead on medication safety and conduct audits to improve prescribing practices. Certain medications require regular blood monitoring (e.g. anticoagulants, methotrexate, lithium etc.) and they ensure that patients are invited for blood monitoring, so that prescribing remains safe.

Our clinical pharmacy team offers in-depth medication knowledge into general practice, bridging gaps between hospital and community care, and improving patient outcomes.

## **Spring Covid Vaccinations 2025**

The Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) has confirmed its advice for a 2025 spring coronavirus booster programme. The committee has advised that a spring booster dose should be offered to:

- Adults aged 75 years and over. This will include those who will turn 75 years by 17<sup>th</sup> June 2025.
- Residents in a care home for older adults
- Individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed

The programme for all eligible patients will commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> April running until 17<sup>th</sup> June 2025. The vaccination should be offered no earlier than around 6 months after the last vaccine dose.

The Westgate Practice will not be participating in the spring booster programme. This is due to the programme requiring many clinical and administrative staff to run these clinics. This would result in taking staff away from the practice and ultimately lead to a reduction in appointments and services for the remainder of our patient population.

Our care home residents and eligible housebound patients will be contacted by Springpharm Pharmacy in due course.

Patients who receive a text message or letter from the NHS to book their spring booster, are advised to book via the National Booking Service online from 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025 or to source the vaccination from their local pharmacy/provider.
